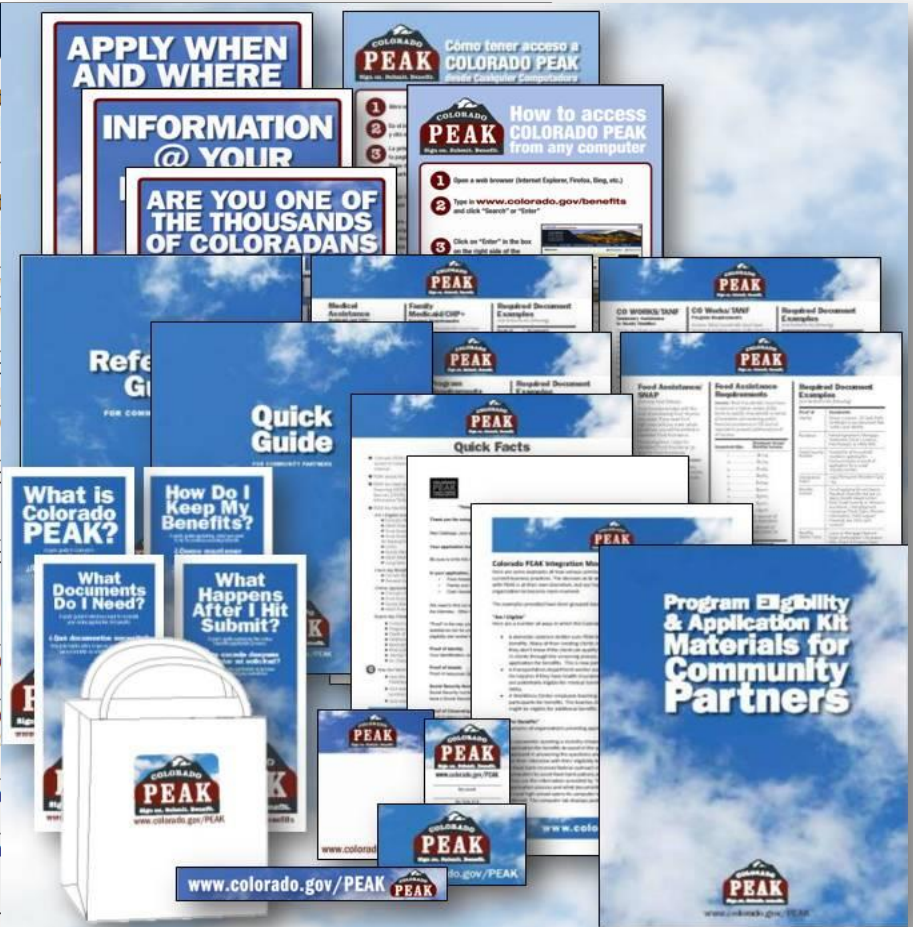

- Considering the following:

TRAINING PURPOSE

To strengthen community organization capacity to:

Convey key elements of the ACA to clients and constituents

Help clients understand and access benefits potentially available to them

Support client's submission of applications and managing accounts, for public assistance

Be prepared to support local implementation of the ACA



Key Learnings

- The ACA is aimed at reducing the number of uninsured, accomplished via:
 - Expanding eligibility for Public Assistance through the Medical Assistance Program
 - Creating Marketplaces for private insurance with requirements for standards of coverage
 - Modernized eligibility & enrollment rules and systems
- Colorado anticipates that somewhere close to 70% of the roughly 1M uninsured will become insured; 150K becoming Medicaid eligible

Key Learnings

- Connect for Health Colorado is Colorado's Marketplace.
 - It provides a marketplace for private health insurance
 - Applicants up to 400%FPL may be eligible for financial assistance through the Marketplace
 - C4HCO Guides or Certified Application counselors are available at locations all around the state to help people use the Marketplace
- The Medical Assistance Program is for the high level public health insurance benefit program
 - Eligibility expansions go into effect 1/1/2014
 - New eligibility methodology (MAGI) goes into effect 10/1/2013



Key Learnings

- One single streamlined application is in place for Insurance Affordability Programs
- Applications can be made online (PEAK), via paper or over the phone
- C4HCO, PEAK, CBMS and data hubs interface to create a streamlined, electronic system where verifications are automated and Real Time Eligibility is available (via PEAK)
- PEAK provides multiple points of entry to apply – new or returning users, with or without existing benefits
 - Manage My Account provides significant enhancement to managing benefits
