Women Infants and Children (WIC) is a nutrition program that provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and nutritious foods to supplement a routine diet. In addition to using PEAK's *Am I Eligible?* tool to check for potential Food and Cash Assistance benefits, individuals will also receive information about potential eligibility for WIC's nutritional service benefits.

We will ask you to tell us about:

- The people in your home
- The money you get from a job or other places
- Your housing costs like rent, mortgage, and utilities
- Some of the things you own
- A few of your other bills

When you're finished, we'll tell you if you might be able to get help through programs that provide:

- Food Assistance
- Cash Assistance
- Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
