

Women Infants and Children (WIC) is a nutrition program that provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and nutritious foods to supplement a routine diet. In addition to using PEAK's *Am I Eligible?* tool to check for potential Food and Cash Assistance benefits, individuals will also receive information about potential eligibility for WIC's nutritional service benefits.

Assesses potential eligibility;


Applications are submitted at WIC offices

Links to WIC office locator


Clients already receiving Medicaid or Food Assistance can print proof of benefits from PEAK for WIC
